School Sports Funding

For the year 2019 to 2020, our school received £16,980 School Sports Funding and this year, 2020-21, we will receive £16,790 in two instalments.

This was/will be used to:

- Employ specialist coaches to work alongside staff to improve skills. These included specialist tennis coaching, football, multi-skills, boot camp, top up swimming, tag rugby skills, fencing, golf, cricket, athletics, dance, golf, archery.
- Provide enrichment sports facilities such as the climbing wall and scooters and skateboard taster sessions.
- Employ staff to run competitions for inter school games to increase participation in competitive sports.
- Subsidise extended school sports provision
- Establish strong sustainable partnerships with other local schools to provide joint sports activities.
- Pay for transport to inter school sports events
- Provide specialist sports enrichment days to inspire and enrich sporting excellence, such as the climbing wall, archery practice.
- Provide cover for staff to plan and evaluate sports provision.
- Provide cover for staff to work across our academy trust to plan and evaluate sports provision.
- Evaluate the effectiveness of the sports provision.

Impact

- Every year group involved in at least 1 inter-school competition per year with at least 80% of children participating.
- Improved performance at competitive completion
- Increased confidence in children
- More children participating in sports clubs, both in school and out of school
- Greater interest in sports
- Provide cover for staff to work across our academy trust to plan and evaluate sports provision.

The Sports Provision will be evaluated through our annual questionnaire to pupils, and by governors and staff as part of our school development procedure.
